PROJECT SUMMARY

A unique opportunity for bright and motivated young people to explore leadership on one of the most innovative courses available. The course will take place from 17 – 24 July 2015, in London, UK.

This is the latest version of Momentum's International Leadership Course, our "flagship" programme which has been running successfully every year since 2010. We can honestly say that this is a unique and life-changing experience for the young people who take part. The next course will run in London in July 2015.

An intensive, innovative and challenging training programme is combined with exceptional social activities and visits, including a visit to the Houses of Parliament, visits to businesses and organisations in the City of London, and a fantastic river boat party and cruise on the Thames. Participants will also benefit from a personal profile exercise normally available only to professionals in the corporate sector.

Apart from the Momentum team, trainers will include Paul van Casteren, a renowned management coach who works with senior executives of multinational companies, and the head of human resources from one of the UK's leading recruitment companies.

Participants will get a deep understanding of their own leadership style, their career ambitions and motivations, and the next steps they need to take in their career development. Feedback from all previous courses has been outstanding, with participants reporting that they have found jobs, new ideas and ambitions, a new level of self awareness, and (of course) new friends for life. Participants should be highly motivated young people aged 20-25 - typically, recent graduates, young professionals or university students. There will be 2 participants per country / partner.

The fee for this course will be 250 euros. The reason for these fees is that we aim to provide the highest



quality activities and trainers, as well as the best available standard of accommodation, food and social programme. Participants will get an exceptional educational, professional and personal experience.

ACTIVITY 1 [A1]

International leadership course, 7 days in London, UK

Dates: 17 - 24 July 2015

Place: London, UK (venue to be confirmed)

<u>Participants</u>: 2 per country. The course is suitable for dynamic, highly motivated young people aged between 20 and 25. A good level of English is required.

Participation fee: €250.

Partner responsibilities

- Ensure your group is well informed about the project and committed to full participation in all activities.
- Select suitable participants as early as possible
- Send Momentum a list of participants (name, surname, sex, date of birth, passport number, email address)
- Ensure all participants send us a completed Registration Form and pay their fees
- Help with preparation and make sure participants are well informed about the project, travel, etc.
- Make travel bookings in accordance with advice from Momentum (note: please do <u>not</u> make final bookings / payments until authorised by us!)
- Ensure that all participants <u>arrive on time and stay for the full duration</u> of the project (Momentum will <u>not</u> accept late arrivals or early departures)
- Collect and verify all invoices, receipts and travel documents; send to Momentum within 1 week after the
 activity

Participant preparation

- Complete registration form and pay fees
- Complete pre-course questionnaire
- Prepare a short presentation (maximum 10 minutes) about your organization, your projects and education and employment issues in your own country.
- Prepare a short (5 minutes) activity for the intercultural evening. This can include songs, dance, games, traditions etc. Must be interactive and fun for other participants to join in. Also please bring some food and drink from your country.
